Mike Krause, president of the N.E.W. Riders ATV Club, addressed the Board about a proposed trail project for Pound and Coleman which will eventually expand into a statewide system. Krause presented a map of the Village streets which delineated a trail along Colburn Street, Larson Street, Parkview Lane and crossing behind Sotka's and the DNR Station. Space is available for a Park and Ride along the railroad property.

"If the Highway goes around, there isn't going much for business anymore. We have got to do whatever we can to attract business interest. We need to have businesses renting our buildings to keep them from dilapidation. If we lose their contribution to our tax roll – it means higher taxes for everybody," Kevin Schutte said. Board members agreed to establish the proposed ATV trail system according to the plans presented.
